The South Center Chautauqua Lake Sewer District in Celoron, NY is currently accepting applications for a Sewage Treatment Plant Attendant. This is semi- skilled work involving the responsibility for assisting in the cleaning, operation and maintenance of equipment, buildings and grounds at a sewage treatment plant. Direct supervision is received from sewage treatment plant staff of higher rank. The work is performed according to, and requires strict adherence to, established practices and procedures.

Typical Work Activities:

- Tends pumps, conveyors, blowers, chlorinators, vacuum filters, incinerator and related equipment;
- Reads and records data from charts, flow meters and other gauges;
- Assists in cleaning, operating and maintaining sewage pumps, pipes, screens, tanks, filters and related equipment;
- Performs routine custodial and minor maintenance tasks in the care of buildings and equipment;
- Lubricates valves, pumps and other equipment;
- Performs a variety of minor housekeeping and groundskeeping tasks, such as washing floors, cutting grass, lawn watering and caring for shrubs;
- Assists in a variety of other related manual tasks;
- Removes snow and ice from walks and driveways;
- May operate light automotive equipment and NYS Class B dump and flush trucks in the performance of duties.
