

AIRCRAFT RESCUE AND FIRE FIGHTING WORKER (PT)
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC FACILITIES
STARTING SALARY - \$38.30/HOUR

The Chautauqua County Department of Public Facilities is currently accepting applications for the title of Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting Worker. This position exists only as a part-time job, which is normally performed in conjunction with other employment at the Chautauqua County Airport in Jamestown. It involves skilled work in the rescue of persons from airplane crashes and/or fires, as needed. Employees who are engaged in active fire or rescue work, or who are participating in annual hot-fire drills will be compensated in this title for hours actually worked. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- Operates rescue truck to site of disaster or fire;
- Employs firefighting techniques to quell blaze;
- Assists victims from disaster area;
- May perform first aid as needed;
- May perform other activities as required by FAA regulations concerning crash/fire/rescue protection.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS - None.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. Completion of Essentials of Firefighting and Crash/Fire/Rescue training courses, within one year of appointment.
2. Ability to pass OSHA required physical examination for self-contained breathing apparatus during service in this title.
